The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is making available \$5 million in assistance through the Choice Neighborhoods Initiative for Planning & Action Grants and anticipates awarding up to 3 Action grants not to exceed \$1.3 million each and 3 Planning grants \$350,000.00 at each.

The Choice Neighborhoods grant must be used for physical community development or economic development projects that enhance and accelerate the transformation of the neighborhood. The projects funded may also build community capacity and social cohesion through the way in which the projects are designed, led and implemented. Action Activities funding should be used for innovative solutions to neighborhood challenges such as:

- Homeowner and business façade improvement programs
- Beautification, Place-making and community art projects
- Neighborhood broadband programs
- Fresh food initiatives including mobile fresh food vendors
- GAP financing for economic development projects that are ready for implementation
- Reclaiming and recycling vacant property into community gardens, pocket parks, farmers markets, or land banking.
